



## 5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Spring Concert Information

Our Wizard of Oz-themed vocal concert *This Way to Oz* will be on Thursday, April 26, in the gym, at 7:00pm. Parent or other relatives are welcome at the final rehearsal that afternoon, 2:00pm.

**Arrival:** Doors for the evening concert will open at 6:30. Students should arrive by 6:45 and report to the cafeteria to warm up.

### **Evening Attire for Performers:**

**TOPS:** Plain, solid-colored, short-sleeve t-shirts

- Shirts should NOT have patterns, logos, or pictures
- Shirts should NOT have buttons or be v-neck (crew neck, please)
- Shirts may have a pocket.
- Black, white, and grey are acceptable but not preferable (bright colors would be better!)
- If your student doesn't own a plain t-shirt, feel free to wear one inside out (and if the tag isn't stamped on, just cut it off). Otherwise, I would highly recommend checking the thrift shop.

**BOTTOMS:** Denim blue jeans

- Can be light or dark blue, but no other colors, please
- They should not look like leggings ~ some "jeggings" are pretty thick so that would be fine ~ as long as when we look at them we think "oh, those are jeans, not leggings," then they're okay.
- No capris, shorts, skirts, or sweatpants.
- The students will be dancing so make sure that your student is wearing a belt if necessary!

**SHOES:** Athletic tennis shoes or sneakers (no sandals or boots)

**MAKEUP & HAIR** for the ladies:

- Bows, headbands, hair flowers etc. are allowed
- Girls may paint their nails (and keep them for school the next day)
- I would honestly prefer the students NOT wear makeup ~ we want them to look like the beautiful 11-14 year-olds they are... so I will be encouraging them to wear little to no makeup in the interest of tastefulness. Please no noticeable lipstick, etc.

**DEPARTURE:** The concert ends informally, with a mini "dance party." If you will need to leave quickly, I would recommend agreeing on a meeting location with your child.
