

Dear Parents and Students:

It's the start another school year at St. Teresa's! As you know, there have been many exciting changes going on with the renovation! The Library has moved to a new room (the old 5th grade classroom) in the old building.

This past summer has been busy moving all the books from the old library to the new one. We weeded out a lot of old books and duplicate books at the end of the year and I want to thank all of you who gave a lot of these books a new home and particularly those who made generous donations to the library in the process. The funds from book sales will go toward purchasing books for the new library!

Grade 1, 2B, 3 and 6 check out books on **Monday**.

Grade KA, 2A, 4A and 5 check out books on **Tuesday**.

Grade 4B checks out books on **Thursday**.

Grade KB checks out books on **Friday**.

Grades 7 & 8 check out books on **Thursday**.

Just a quick reminder of library procedure and policy:

Check Out

- A. 2 books
- B. 2 weeks
- C. books must be returned before 2 more can be checked out
- D. fine applies after renewal date has passed
- E. fine is .05 per school day per book (KA and KB are not assessed fines)

Book Return

Students may return books in their class library basket any time. If a student is not here for library class...he/she may come in at any time to return books. There is a book return basket in the library for older students who do not have library book return baskets in the classroom. If it is not their regular scheduled library time and there is not a class in session, they are allowed to check out books if I am in the library.

Fines are computed by the library software. If a student is absent or we do not have school, I will negotiate the fine. On early dismissal days the students are still required to return books on the day they are due, even if they do not have class.

All fines need to be paid and overdue books returned before report cards are issued.
