General Guidelines for Service Hours

All Grades:

- 1) Service time may NOT be paid time, but if the student receives money, it should be given to a charity.
- 2) Service during school hours may be done during recess time, before or after school, and study hall.
**Service completed during class time (volunteering in classrooms, cleaning etc.) may not be counted.
- 3) Student Council sponsored service trips (Meals on Wheels, Pioneers Park, etc.) may not be included.
- 4) Altar Servers may count time if they volunteer to substitute for a scheduled server, not scheduled times.
- 5) Clubs (Boy Scouts, Little Flowers, sports teams): If a club is doing service projects during their meeting, it does not count.
**But if a club is sponsoring a service project outside of the meeting time, it may be counted.
- 6) Service hours may be done between May 1, 2018 and April 4, 2019.
- 7) ***Service hour logs due April 5, 2019 for all grades except 5th, see note below.***

1st-4 Grades:

- 1) Encouraged to have 5 hours of service.
- 2) Certificates will be issued for completed service hours for grades 1 – 4.

5th Grade

- 1) 10 hours required for Confirmation. Please turn in the Confirmation service log to the office or your homeroom teacher by deadline given at the Confirmation meeting.

6th Grade

- 1) 10 hours of service are required and will receive a grade in your religion class according to hours served.

2) Service log should be turned into your religion teacher.

Junior High:

- 1) 15 hours are required and will receive a grade according to hours served.
- 2) Service Log due to your religion teacher by **April 05, 2019.**
- 3) Late service hours follow the same plan as late homework.
